ORDINANCE NO. 3488

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Military Road to Val Vue Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Military Road to Val Vue Sewer District was filed with the County Council effective April 5, 1977.

2. Val Vue Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 757, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Val Vue Sewer District filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated March 11, 1977, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 14th day of November, 1977, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Val Vue Sewer District of the area known as Military Road and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

5 Beginning at the Northeast corner of said Section 34;
6 thence Southerly along the East line of said section to
7 the centerline of South 178th Street; thence Westerly
8 along said centerline to the West line of the East
9 127.54 feet of said Section 34; thence Southerly along
10 said West line to the centerline of South 179th Street;
11 thence Westerly along said centerline to the centerline
12 of Military Road South; thence Northwesterly along the
13 centerline of Military Road South to the North line of
14 said Section 34; thence easterly along said North line
15 to the Point of Beginning.
