ORDINANCE NO. 3540

1 AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of
2 \$111,500 to the River Improvement Fund
3 from the Federal Disaster Assistance Program
4 to meet the emergent needs created by recent
heavy flooding in King County, amending
Ordinance 2988, Section 43, as amended, and
declaring an emergency.

5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

6 SECTION 1. The amount of \$111,500 is hereby appropriated from
7 the Federal Disaster Assistance Program to the River Improvement
8 Fund to meet the emergent needs created by recent, heavy flooding
9 in King County.

10 SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2988, Section 43, as amended, is
11 hereby amended to read as follows:

12 From the River Improvement Fund there is hereby appropriated:

13 ~~(\$1,123,897)~~ \$1,235,397

14 PROVIDED THAT:

15 All provisos adopted by the Council in Ordinance No. 2988
16 shall be fulfilled.

17 SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares
18 that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for
19 the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety
20 or for the support of County Government and its existing institu-
21 tions.
