ORDINANCE NO. 3604

AN ORDINANCE relating to the establishment of 23rd Avenue South (South 312th Street to 24th Avenue South).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Director of the Department of Public Works and Transportation has made an examination of 23rd Avenue South along the course and description set forth below and has made a favorable report upon the same, as required by R.C.W. 36.81.050.

SECTION 2. Said road shall be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at the intersection of South 312th Street and 23rd Avenue South, said point being 328.88 feet westerly of the center of Section 9, Township 21 North, Range 4 East, W.M., King County, Washington; thence in a southerly direction a distance of 1985.11 feet to a point of terminus on the centerline of 24th Avenue South.

(1985.11 feet = 0.376 mile)

SECTION 3: King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway, along the course and description set forth, is a public necessity.
