ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Duwamish Marina to King County Water District No. 20.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Duwamish Marina to King County Water District No. 20 was filed with the County Council effective January 26, 1978.
2. King County Water District No. 20 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 456, concurred with the proposed annexation.
3. King County Water District No. 20 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated December 16, 1977, on the proposed annexation.
4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1978, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 20 of the area known as Duwamish Marina and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Duwamish Marina to be annexed

1 is described as follows:

2 That portion of John Buckley Donation Claim No. 42 situated in  
3 the southwest quarter of Section 33, T24N, R4E, W.M., described  
as follows:

4 Beginning at a point on the west line of the southwest  
5 quarter of Section 33, T24N, R4E, W.M. at the  
6 intersection of said west line and the north line of  
7 Tract 4, Moore's Five Acre Tracts according to the plat  
8 thereof recorded in volume 9 page 28 of plats, records  
9 of King County, Washington. Said point also being on  
10 the existing boundary line of Water District No. 20,  
11 King County, Washington; thence proceed northerly along  
12 said west line of southwest quarter and the existing  
13 boundary of Water District No. 20 to the northerly  
14 boundary of S. 93rd Street; said boundary being  
15 approximately 630 feet northerly of the north line of  
16 said Tract 4; thence easterly along said northerly  
17 boundary of S. 93rd Street and the easterly projection  
18 of said boundary to the southwesterly margin of  
19 Commercial Waterway District No. 1; thence southerly  
20 along said waterway margin to the intersection with the  
21 east line of Tract 1, Moore's Five Acre Tracts and the  
22 existing boundary of Water District No. 20; thence  
23 westerly approximately 70 feet along the boundary of  
24 Tract 1, Moore's Five Acre Tracts and Water District  
25 No. 20 boundary; thence northwesterly approximately 256  
26 feet along the boundary of Tract 1, Moore's Five Acre  
27 Tracts and Water District No. 20 boundary, to the north  
28 line of Tract 1, Moore's Five Acre Tracts; thence  
29 westerly along the north line of Tracts 1, 2, 3, and 4  
30 of Moore's Five Acre Tracts and Water District No. 20  
31 boundary to the intersection with the west line of the  
32 southwest quarter of Section 33, T24N, R4E, W.M. said  
33 intersection being the point of beginning.
