

ORDINANCE NO. 3639

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$455,263 of Federal Shared Revenue in Social Programs Contingency and unappropriated Federal Shared Revenue Fund balance to Federal Shared Revenue Fund-Human Services; and amending Ordinance No. 3492, Section 57, as amended.

SECTION 1. An appropriation of \$455,263 of Federal Shared Revenue in Social Programs Contingency and unappropriated Federal Shared Revenue Fund balance to the Federal Shared Revenue Fund-Human Services is hereby approved and adopted.
