ORDINANCE NO. 3666

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Bunce to King County Water District No. 58.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Bunce to King County Water District No. 58 was filed with the County Council effective March 7, 1978.

2. King County Water District No. 58 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolutions 1670 and 1671, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 58 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated February 14, 1978, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 10th day of April, 1978, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 58 of the area known as Bunce and described in Section 2 herein is approved.
