4 to be elected in each justice court district;  
5 providing for the location of a central  
6 office, courtroom and records of each court;  
7 authorizing justice court commissioners when  
8 necessary; providing for departments into  
9 which each justice court shall be initially  
10 organized; providing for the name of each  
11 justice court district; providing for the  
12 allocation of time and salary of each justice  
13 who serves part-time as a municipal judge;  
14 setting the boundaries of each justice court  
15 district; repealing Ordinance No. 2102,  
16 Sections 1 through 27 and KCC 2.68.010  
17 through 2.68.260; repealing Ordinance No.  
18 2694, Sections 1 through 25; repealing  
19 Ordinance no. 3671, Sections 1 through 17.

12 PREAMBLE:

13 This ordinance contains provisions requiring that it  
14 not take effect until January 13, 1979; the present  
15 effective date by which all elected judges of the  
16 district court will have served their elected term of  
17 office, under the provisions of RCW 3.34. It is  
18 understood that activities of the court may require  
19 amendments to the present district court plan,  
20 Ordinance No. 2102, prior to this ordinance having  
21 legal effect. In those cases where amendments are  
22 necessary, it is the intent of the Council that such  
23 amendments shall be prepared to amend the present  
24 district court plan and this ordinance, the future  
25 district court plan, scheduled to be effective  
26 January 13, 1979.
