ORDINANCE NO. 3741

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$155,694 to the River Improvement Fund from the Federal Disaster Assistance Administration; making an appropriation of \$61,321 to Special Programs from unappropriated Current Expense Fund balance and making an appropriation of \$61,321 to the River Improvement Fund from Special Programs, funds to be used for repair and restoration work necessitated by the heavy flooding of King County in December, 1977, amending Ordinance No. 3492, Sections 40 and 42 as amended and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation of \$155,694 is hereby approved and adopted to the River Improvement Fund from the Federal Disaster Assistance Program.

SECTION 2. An appropriation of \$61,321 is hereby approved and adopted to Special Programs from unappropriated Current Expense Fund balance.

SECTION 3. An appropriation of \$61,321 is hereby approved and adopted to the River Improvement Fund from Special Programs funds to be used for repair and restoration work necessitated by the heavy flooding of King County in December, 1977.

SECTION 4. Ordinance No. 3492, Section 40, is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to Special Programs: ~~(\$3,720,126)~~ \$3,781,447

PROVIDED THAT:

All provisos adopted by the Council in Ordinance NO. 3492 shall be fulfilled.

SECTION 5. Ordinance No. 3492, Section 42, is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the River Improvement Fund there is hereby appropriated: ~~(\$1,201,369)~~ \$1,418,384
