



PROJECT TITLE: Skykomish Feasibility Study

NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION: Phase I of this project consists of a feasibility study to investigate the alternatives available to provide for disposal of solid waste from the City of Skykomish and the surrounding area. The alternatives will include but not be limited to disposal in the Skykomish area, in Snohomish County, and through the existing King County waste handling system. A user survey will be performed to determine waste characteristics and quantities. Economic and environmental impacts of each alternative will be evaluated. The recommended alternative will fully detail necessary administrative requirements; necessary agreements; manpower; facility and equipment requirements; the scheduled design, construction, and capital acquisition program; and the method of financing both capital costs and operating expenditures.

The GRANTEE shall submit five (5) copies of the final report to the DEPARTMENT.

Phase II of this project consists of preliminary survey work, soil analysis, and design necessary for the preparation of an Unclassified Use Permit Application which is required to gain approval of the desired land use by the King County Building and Land Development Division and the King County Council.
