ORDINANCE NO. 3809

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$200,000 to the Human Services Fund for the Drug Treatment Services rendered in Fiscal Year 1978, amending Ordinance No. 3492, Sections 40 and 45, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The amount of \$106,000 is hereby appropriated to the Human Services Fund from additional revenues to be received from the National Institute of Drug Abuse for the payment of Drug Treatment services rendered in Fiscal Year 1978. PROVIDED THAT: Disbursements will be contingent upon receipt of commitment from the National Institute of Drug Abuse for \$106,000.

SECTION 2. The amount of \$94,000 is hereby appropriated to Special Programs in the Current Expense Fund from unappropriated Current Expense Fund balance and to the Human Services Fund from Special Programs for the payment of Drug Treatment services rendered in Fiscal Year 1978.

SECTION 3. All disbursements of this \$200,000 appropriation by the Center for Addiction Services shall be made under the supervision of the County Executive's Office.

SECTION 4. The selection process for the Financial Manager's position at the Center for Addiction Services shall be initiated immediately. Such process shall include creation of a selection panel to make recommendations on candidates for the position. The County Executive and the County Auditor are each hereby requested to make one representative available for service on such panel.

SECTION 5. Ordinance No. 3492, Section 40, as amended, is hereby amended as follows:

From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to: Special Programs ((~~\$3,859,947~~)) \$3,953,947
