ORDINANCE NO. 3811

AN ORDINANCE relating to the dog leash law; establishing a dog control zone located in the vicinity of Eastgate; adding a new section to Ordinance No. 3548 and KCC 11.08.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

NEW SECTION. SECTION 1. There is added to Ordinance No. 3548 and KCC 11.08 a new section to read as follows:

Dog Control Zones Designated. Under the provisions of this chapter, there is created a dog control zone in the following described area near Eastgate:

All of the unincorporated area of King County lying within the following subdivision in Township 24 North, Range 5 East, W.M.; the South half of the South half of Section 10; the South half of the Southwest quarter of Section 11; the North half of the Northwest quarter of Section 14; the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 14; the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 14; the Northeast quarter of Section 15; the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 15.
