ORDINANCE NO. 3818

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Gustaveson to King County Water District No. 82.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Gustaveson to King County Water District No. 82 was filed with the County Council effective May 12, 1978.

2. King County Water District No. 82 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 349, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 82 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated April 26, 1978, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on July 10, 1978, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District of the area known as Gustaveson and described in Section 2 herein is approved.
