AN ORDINANCE approving a portion of King County Water District No. 105 Comprehensive Plan

PREAMBLE:

Water District 105 approved the formation and construction of U.L.I.D. numbers 4 and 6 by Resolution No. 522 on December 5, 1977.

Water District 105 incorporated U.L.I.D. numbers 4 and 6 into their Comprehensive Plan by Resolution No. 544 on April 3, 1978.

Water District 105 filed a Declaration of Non-Significance on August 1, 1977, for the proposed Comprehensive Plan.

The Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed plan as required by KCC 13.24 and in January 11, 1978, recommended approval of the proposed plan.

BE IT ORDIANED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The portion of King County Water District 105 Comprehensive Plan within the boundaries of U.L.I.D. numbers 4 and 6 are hereby approved.
