7 ORDINANCE NO. 3883

8 AN ORDINANCE amending King County Zoning Resolution  
9 No. 25789, as amended, by amending the Zoning Map  
10 thereof reclassifying certain property thereon at  
the request of Edward Tilton, et al, Building and  
Land Development Division File No. 165-77-R.

11 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

12 SECTION 1. Edward Tilton, et al petitioned on August 11, 1977,  
13 that the property described in Section 3 below be reclassified from  
14 CG to M-L and this application was assigned Building and Land Devel-  
15 opment Division File No. 165-77-R.

16 SECTION 2. The report and recommendation of the Building and  
17 Land Development Division was transmitted to the Zoning and Subdivi-  
18 sion Examiner on October 4, 1977, and hearing was held by the Exam-  
19 iner on the matter October 11, 1977. The report of the Examiner was  
20 filed with the Clerk of the King County Council on January 5, 1978,  
21 and the Council approved the reclassification by Motion No. 03414 on  
22 March 13, 1978, subject to conditions which will be satisfied per  
23 the "P" suffix.

24 SECTION 3. The legal description of the property to be re-  
25 classified is attached as Appendix A and is hereby made a part of  
26 this ordinance. The above described property is shown on the at-  
27 tached map which is designated Appendix B and is hereby made a part  
28 of this ordinance.

29 SECTION 4. The King County Council does hereby amend King  
30 County Zoning Code, Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifiy-

1 fying that property described and shown in Section 3, Appendices A  
2 and B above, to M-L-P and directs that Area Map W 10-26-5 be modi-  
3 fied to so designate.

4 SECTION 5. This reclassification is granted subject to condi-  
5 tions adopted in Motion No. 03414 and said conditions are incorpor-  
6 ated herein as though fully set forth herein.


