AN ORDINANCE establishing the permanent closure of the alley at Easterly R/W line of 2nd Avenue S. W. to all thoroughfare traffic

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the construction of 2nd Avenue S. W. between S. W. 153rd St. and S. W. 154th St., the following Alley is hereby authorized to be closed to all thoroughfare traffic on a permanent basis:

Alley To Be Closed;

The alley running Easterly from proposed 2nd Avenue S. W. to 1st Avenue S. between S. W. 153rd St. and S. W. 154th St. at the Easterly R/W line of 2nd Avenue S. W.

SECTION 2. The Department of Public Works and Transportation is authorized to erect a permanent barricade and post the necessary traffic control signs and notice of closure.

SECTION 3. After the effective date of the closure, any unauthorized use of the above-described location shall constitute a misdemeanor.
