6 PREAMBLE:

7 Eastgate Sewer District adopted Resolution No. 398 on May 16, 1978 pro-
8 viding for the "By-pass Trunk" additions and betterments to the district's
9 comprehensive plan.

10 Eastgate Sewer District adopted Resolution No. 399 on May 16, 1978
11 providing for the "128th Street Area" additions and betterments to the
12 district's comprehensive plan.

13 Eastgate Sewer District filed Declarations of Non-Significance for the
14 "By-pass Trunk" on April 18, 1978. The 128th Street area improvements are
15 exempt from SEPA requirements as provided in K.C.C. 20.44.030 and W.A.C.
16 197-10-170 (18).

17 The Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed Additions
18 and Betterments as required by K.C.C. 13.24 and on June 14, 1978 recommended
19 their approval.

20 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

21 SECTION 1. The "By-pass Trunk" and "128th Street Area" additions and
22 betterments as adopted by Eastgate Sewer District, Resolutions No. 398 and
23 399 (attached) are hereby approved.

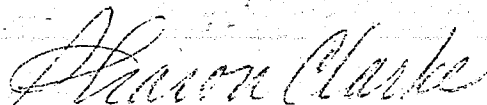
