

ORDINANCE NO. 3942

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Crescent Hills to Lakehaven Sewer District, and declaring an emergency.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Crescent Hills to Lakehaven Sewer District was filed with the County Council effective September 14, 1978.

2. Lakehaven Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 78-622, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Lakehaven Sewer District filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated September 13, 1978, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on October 16, 1978, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Lakehaven Sewer District of the area known as Crescent Hills and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Crescent Hills to be annexed is described as follows:

The North 658.46 feet of the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter and the North 658.46 feet of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter, lying Easterly of the centerline of 47th Avenue Southwest; ALL in Section 14, Township 21 North, Range 3 East, W.M., King County, Washington.

SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
