ORDINANCE NO. 3957

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$255,544 to the Department of Rehabilitative Services to provide for twelve Corrections Officer positions and cost overruns, amending Ordinance No. 3492, Section 28, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation of \$216,010 from the 1977 unappropriated Current Expense Fund balance is hereby approved and adopted to the Department of Rehabilitative Services to pay for cost overruns attributable primarily to unanticipated hospital guarding requirements.

SECTION 2. Appropriations of \$33,241 from 1977 unappropriated Current Expense Fund balance and \$6,293 from anticipated billings to the Involuntary Treatment Fund are hereby approved and adopted to the Department of Rehabilitative Services to provide twelve corrections officer positions to address increased booking activity, increased jail security requirements and transfer of the responsibility for transporting involuntary treatment clients to and from court hearings from the Department of Public Safety to the Department of Rehabilitative Services.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 3492, Section 28, as amended, is hereby amended to read:


