ORDINANCE NO. 3986

AN ORDINANCE approving an amendment to the Water District 105's Comprehensive Plan known as ULID No. 5.

PREAMBLE:

Water District 105 approved the formation and construction of ULID No. 5 by Resolution No. 522 on December 5, 1977.

Water District incorporated ULID No. 5 into their Comprehensive Plan by Resolution No. 544 on April 3, 1978.

The facilities proposed in this plan amendment are exempt from the requirements of the State Environmental Policy Act.

The Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed plan as required by KCC 13.24 and on January 11, 1978, recommended approval of the proposed plan.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. That portion of King County Water District 105 Comprehensive Plan within the boundaries of ULID No. 5 is hereby approved.
