AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$27,000 to the Department of Rehabilitative Services from unanticipated Jail Commissary revenue to fully support 1978 Jail Commissary operations, amending Ordinance No. 3492, Section 23, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation of \$27,000 from the unanticipated Jail Commissary revenue is hereby approved and adopted to the Department of Rehabilitative Services to fully support 1978 Jail Commissary Operations.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 3492, Section 28, as amended, is hereby amended to read:

Rehabilitative Services

SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of County government and its existing public institutions.
