5 ORDINANCE NO. 4049

6 AN ORDINANCE amending King County Zoning Resolution
7 No. 25789, as amended, by amending the Zoning Map
8 thereof reclassifying certain property thereon at
the request of Harold J. Storm, Building and Land
Development Division File No. 174-78-R.

9 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

10 SECTION 1. Harold J. Storm petitioned on May 1, 1978, that
11 the property described in Section 3 below be reclassified from SR
12 to RM 1800 and this application was assigned Building and Land
13 Development Division File No. 174-78-R.

14 SECTION 2. The report and recommendation of the Building and
15 Land Development Division was transmitted to the Zoning and Sub-
16 division Examiner on August 3, 1978, and hearing was held by the
17 Examiner on the matter August 10, 1978. The report of the Examiner
18 was filed with the Clerk of the King County Council on November 2,
19 1978, and the Council approved the reclassification by Motion No.
20 03829 on November 6, 1978, subject to conditions which will be sat-
21 isfied per the "P" suffix.

22 SECTION 3. The legal description of the property to be re-
23 classified is attached as Appendix A and is hereby made a part of
24 this ordinance. The above described property is shown on the at-
25 tached map which is designated Appendix B and is hereby made a part
26 of this ordinance.

27 SECTION 4. The King County Council does hereby amend King
28 County Zoning Code, Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassi-
29 fying that property described and shown in Section 3, Appendices A
30

1 and B above, to RM 1800-P and directs that Area Map E 10-26-5 be
2 modified to so designate.

3 SECTION 5. This reclassification is granted subject to condi-
4 tions adopted in Motion No. 03829 and said conditions are incorpor-
5 ated herein as though fully set forth herein.
