ORDINANCE NO. 4057

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$1,000 from unappropriated Current Expense Fund balance to implement an agreement among the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle, the State of Washington and King County to provide improved local and commuting transit service for Vashon-Maury residents, authorizing the execution of said agreement and amending Ordinance 3969, Sections 43 and 58.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$1,000 to Special Programs, Current Expense Fund from unappropriated Current Expense Fund balance and to the Equipment Rental and Revolving Fund to provide improved local and commuting transit services for Vashon-Maury residents as prescribed in an inter-local agreement between King County, the State of Washington, and the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 3969, Section 43, is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to Special Programs ((~~\$7,215,387~~)) \$7,216,387

Provided that:

All provisos adopted by the Council in Ordinance 3969, as amended, shall be fulfilled.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 3969, Section 58 is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the Public Works ER&R Fund there is hereby appropriated to Equipment Rental and Revolving Fund
