ORDINANCE NO. 4076

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Lurie to King County Water District No. 82.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Lurie to King County Water District No. 82 was filed with the County Council effective September 28, 1978.

2. King County Water District No. 82 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 366, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 82 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated September 12, 1978, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on October 30, 1978, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 82 of the area known as Lurie and described in Section 2 herein is approved.
