

ORDINANCE NO. 4087

AN ORDINANCE carrying over an appropriation of \$10,265 in unappropriated fund balance from Entitlement Nine of the Federal Revenue Sharing Fund, in support of the University Y.W.C.A. Rape Relief program, and amending Ordinance No. 3969, Section 59, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation of \$10,265 in unanticipated fund balance from Entitlement Nine of the Federal Revenue Sharing Fund, for the continued support of the University Y.W.C.A. Rape Relief program previously authorized by ordinance, is hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 3969, Section 59, is hereby amended to read as follows:
