

ORDINANCE NO. **4118**

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation to the County Road Fund of \$165,000 from the unappropriated fund balance for the construction of Bridlewood Drainage; amending Ordinance 3969, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation to the County Road Fund of \$165,000 from the unappropriated fund balance to complete land acquisition and construction of Bridlewood Drainage, Capital Improvement Project No. 200576.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 3969, Section 71, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

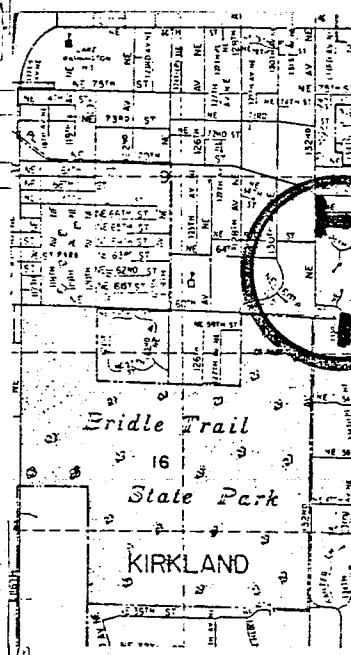
