

ORDINANCE NO. 4121

AN ORDINANCE making appropriations to the CETA title II Fund; amending Ordinance 3969, Section 52, as amended; and reobligating previously authorized funding.

PREAMBLE:

King County has received from the Department of Labor the remainder of the allocations needed to fund its public service employment programs authorized under Titles II and VI of the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act (CETA) for the remainder of Fiscal Year 1979. These allocations will be used to sustain previously authorized positions under CETA Titles II and VI(a) Project Employment Program to replace previously approved projects which have recently ended, and to provide for the special participant training programs required by the CETA Amendments of 1978 (P.L. 95-524).

The funds are distributed as follows:

\$4,987,311 in Title II 1979 Base Funds
\$2,838,056 in Title VI(a) 1979 Base Funds
\$5,493,235 in Title VI(b) 1979 Base Funds

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The CETA Title II Fund (216) is hereby increased to \$4,101,761. The amount of \$1,610,113, previously appropriated by Ordinance 3969, Section 52, as amended, to the Title II Fund (216), is hereby increased by \$2,491,648 to show receipt of full FY'79 grant allocations larger than had been estimated previously. The funding appropriated in this section is to be used to sustain current program obligations through September of 1979, and up to ten percent of the funding appropriated in this section is to be used to provide for the special participant training programs required by Section 232(b)(2) of the CETA Amendments of 1978 (P.L. 95-524).

SECTION 2. The funding previously appropriated to the CETA Title VI Fund (243) by Ordinance 3969, Section 52, as amended, is to be used to sustain current program obligations through September of 1979; to create three additional positions which will provide direct supervision of participants in three CETA youth programs as listed in Attachment #4, and up to ten percent of the funding appropriated in this section is to be used to

1 provide for the special participant training programs required by
 2 Section 603(a) of the CETA Amendments of 1978 (P.L. 95-524);
 3 PROVIDED THAT, the following positions are added to Attachment #4
 4 and the CETA fund, thereby authorizing the funding of the said
 5 positions in compliance with CETA regulations:

6 a. One position, \$11,400, Manager, Northshore Chamber of
 7 Commerce; PROVIDED THAT, the agency meets required criteria in
 8 having the capability to process federal funds;

9 b. \$39,000, Senior Citizens Occupational Center; PROVIDED
 10 THAT, funds shall be used to provide services in King County
 11 outside the City of Seattle; PROVIDED FURTHER THAT, the proposed
 12 activities of authorized positions shall be consistent with
 13 previous applications for funding submitted to King County.

14 c. Three positions, Jailers, City of Renton, \$44,064.

15 SECTION 3. The funding previously appropriated to the CETA
 16 Title VI Project Employment Fund (218) by Ordinance 3969, Section
 17 52, as amended, is to be used to sustain program obligations
 18 through the duration of current contracts; to create up to 614
 19 additional positions, as listed in Attachments #1, #2, and #3;
 20 and up to ten percent of the funding appropriated in this section
 21 is to be used to provide for the special participant training
 22 programs required by Section 603(a) of the CETA Amendments of
 23 1978 (P.L. 95-524); PROVIDED THAT, all applications scoring sixty
 24 points or above shall be funded, consistent with CETA regulations
 25 and the County's present contracting process, remaining funds for
 26 projects and positions shall be funded only upon motion of the
 27 Council.

28 SECTION 4. Ordinance 3969, Section 52, as amended, is
 29 hereby amended as follows:

1 SECTION 5. Prior to October 1, 1979, the Executive shall
 2 make recommendations to the Council of what positions or projects
 3 should be funded for the period October 1, 1979, through
 4 September 30, 1980; PROVIDED THAT, any such recommendations that,
 5 contingent on federal funds being available, previously approved
 6 projects having complied with rules, regulations and negotiated
 7 contract provisions, shall receive continued funding for the
 8 stated life of the contract agreement; PROVIDED FURTHER THAT, the
 9 recommendation shall also include a report of program
 10 performance, by individual contract as appropriate; future
 11 funding implications due to completed or anticipated federal or
 12 local policy decisions.
