

ORDINANCE NO. 4156

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as 251B to Cascade Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as 251B to Cascade Sewer District was filed with the County Council effective June 16, 1977.

2. Cascade Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 686, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Cascade Sewer District filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated April 21, 1977, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 15th day of August, 1977, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

5. The annexation is inconsistent with the Soos Creek Community Plan.

6. It is unlikely that sewers would be provided to this proposed annexation in the near future, thus annexation would be inconsistent with RCW 36.93.180(3) relating to the creation and preservation of logical service areas.

7. The proposed annexation is not located within a Local Service Area designated in the County General Sewerage Plan as appropriate for sewerage.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Cascade Sewer District of the area known as 251B and described in Section 2 herein is disapproved.

SECTION 2. The area known as 251B is described as follows:

Beginning at the center of Section 15, Township 22 North, Range 5 East, W.M., in King County, Washington said point being on the existing boundary of Cascade Sewer District.

Thence Northerly along the East line of the West half of said Section 15 to the North line of the South half of the Northeast quarter thereof;

Thence Easterly along said North line and along the North line of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 14, Township 22 North, Range 5 East, W.M. to the East line of said Southwest quarter;

Thence Southerly along said East line to the East-West centerline of said Section 14;

Thence Westerly along said centerline and along the East-West centerline of said Section 15 to the Point of Beginning.
