

ORDINANCE NO. 4175

AN ORDINANCE approving the Comprehensive Plan of Water District 124.

PREAMBLE:

Water District 124 passed Resolution No. 266 on March 6, 1979, which adopted the "Comprehensive Water System Plan, King County Water District No. 124."

Water District No. 124 filed a Declaration of Non-Significance for the proposed plan on March 6, 1979 (Resolution 265).

The Utilities Technical Reveiw Committee reviewed the proposed plan as required by KCC 13.24 and on February 28, 1979 recommended its approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The "Comprehensive Water System Plan, King County Water District No. 124" as adopted by district Resolution No. 266 (attached) is hereby approved; provided that this approval shall not be construed as endorsing or accepting the City of Tacoma's proposed Pipeline No. 5 or facilities plans.



P.S., consulting engineers, have adopted a proposed declaration of non-significance, and have complied with the requirements of WAC 197-10-340 (1)-(6), NOW, THEREFORE,




