AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Brookside Acres to King County Water District No. 104.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Brookside Acres to King County Water District No. 104 was filed with the County Council effective February 15, 1979.

2. King County Water District No. 104 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 890, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 104 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated January 15, 1979, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 16th day of April, 1979, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 104 of the area known as Brookside Acres and described in Section 2 herein is approved, PROVIDED that sewer service shall not be extended to this area until it is included within the Local Service Area of the County's Sewerage General Plan.
