

ORDINANCE NO. 4187

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as DS-50 to Des Moines Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as DS-50 to Des Moines Sewer District was filed with the County Council effective January 14, 1979.

2. Des Moines Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 76-50, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Des Moines Sewer District filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated December 13, 1978, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 16th day of April, 1979, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Des Moines Sewer District of the area known as DS-50 and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

1 SECTION 2. The area known as DS-50 to be annexed is
2 described as follows:

3 That portion of Section 34, Township 23 North, Range 4
4 East, W.M., in King County, Washington, described as
5 follows:

6 Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of
7 South 188th Street and the Easterly margin of Military
8 Road, which is also the Westerly margin of State
9 Highway S.R. 5;

10 Thence Westerly along said centerline to its
11 intersection with the West line of the East one-half of
12 the Southeast one-quarter of said Section 34 (also the
13 centerline of 46th Avenue S.);

14 Thence Northerly along said West line to its
15 intersection with the centerline of South 186th Street;

16 Thence Westerly along said centerline to its
17 intersection with the West line of the Northeast one-
18 quarter of the Northwest one-quarter of the Southeast
19 one-quarter of said Section 34;

20 Thence Northerly along said West line to its
21 intersection with the North line of the Southeast one-
22 quarter of said Section 34;

23 Thence Easterly along said North line to its
24 intersection with the Easterly margin of Military Road;

25 Thence Southerly along said Easterly margin to its
26 intersection with the centerline of South 188th Street
27 and the Point of Beginning.
