ORDINANCE NO. 4213

AN ORDINANCE relating to the withdrawal of an area known as McGonahy from King County Water District No. 56.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the withdrawal of an area known as McGonahy from King County Water District No. 56 was filed with the County Council effective January 24, 1979.

2. King County Water District No. 56 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 239, concurred with the proposed withdrawal.

3. King County Water District No. 56 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated January 18, 1979, on the proposed withdrawal.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 30th day of April, 1979, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The withdrawal from King County Water District No. 56 of the area known as McGonahy and described in Section 2 herein is approved.
