ORDINANCE NO. 4243

AN ORDINANCE establishing the closure of the south end of 227th Pl. S.E., also known as Martin Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to on-site inspection, requests of local residents, and existing loitering by non-local residents, the south end of the following road is hereby authorized to be closed to all vehicular traffic:

The south end, adjacent to the Dorre Don Road, of 227th Pl. S.E., also known as Martin Avenue.

SECTION 2. The Department of Public Works is authorized to erect a barricade and post the necessary traffic control signs and notice of closure.

SECTION 3. After the effective date of closure, the operation of a vehicle through the above-described location shall constitute a misdemeanor.
