

ORDINANCE NO. 4255

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as South Ninth Avenue to Lakehaven Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as South Ninth Avenue to Lakehaven Sewer District was filed with the County Council effective March 28, 1979.

2. Lakehaven Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 79-667, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Lakehaven Sewer District filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated March 1, 1979, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 14th day of May, 1979, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Lakehaven Sewer District of the area known as South Ninth Avenue and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as South Ninth Avenue to be annexed is described as follows:

That portion of Section 20, Township 21 North, Range 4 East, W.M., all in King County, Washington described as follows:



TOGETHER WITH the North  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the Southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 20.




