ORDINANCE NO. **4317**

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$15,000 to Planning and Community Development Administration - Historic Preservation from the Executive Contingency of Special Programs to replace museum assistance funds previously allocated to the Arts Commission that were not transferred with the transfer of museum assistance function to Historic Preservation, and amending Ordinance No. 3969, Sections 21 and 43, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$15,000 to Planning and Community Development Administration - Historic Preservation from the Executive Contingency of Special Programs for the purpose of replacing museum assistance funds previously allocated to the Arts Commission that were not transferred with the transfer of function to Historic Preservation.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 3969, Section 21, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Planning & Community Development Admin. ((~~\$161,463~~)) \$176,463

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 3969, Section 43, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Special Programs ((~~\$4,390,503~~)) \$4,375,503

Included in Special Programs is an Executive Contingency of ((~~\$79,930~~)) \$64,930 which shall not be expended unless the County Executive certifies in writing that funds are available and requests that the County Council adopt an additional appropriation ordinance; upon adoption, such funds may be expended for the purpose specified.

PROVIDED THAT:

All provisos adopted by the Council in Ordinance No. 3969 shall be fulfilled.
