ORDINANCE NO. **4337**

AN ORDINANCE relating to zoning permitting research and testing laboratories in the RM 900 zone; amending Resolution 25789, Section 801, and KCC 21.16.020.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby added to Resolution 25789, Section 801 and KCC 21.16.020 a new permitted use to read as follows:

Research and testing laboratories, provided:

(a) Such laboratory shall be accessory to a professional office directly related to the operation and administration of the laboratory.

(b) The floor area devoted to such use shall not exceed one thousand square feet.

(c) No radioactive substances, other than those commonly used in the function and operation of X-ray equipment shall be permitted on premises.

(d) All testing and storage of materials, supplies and equipment shall be within enclosed buildings.

(e) Noise levels from machines located in such laboratories shall not exceed eighty decibels.

(f) No medical or research experimentation on live animals shall be permitted on premises.
