ORDINANCE NO. 4392

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Sunderhauf to King County Water District No. 82, and declaring an emergency.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Sunderhauf to King County Water District No. 82 was filed with the County Council effective May 25, 1979.
- 2. King County Water District No. 82 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution A381, concurred with the proposed annexation.
- 3. King County Water District No. 82 filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated April 30, 1979, on the proposed annexation.
- 4. The County Council held a public hearing on the ______ day o _______, 1979, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 82 of the area known as Sunderhauf and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Sunderhauf to be annexed is described as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of the southeast quarter of Section 8, Township 24 North, Range 6 East, W.M., in King County, Washington; thence southerly along the west line of said southeast quarter to the northwest corner of Government Lot 2 in Section 17 of said township and range; thence continuing southerly along the west line of said Government Lot 2 to the centerline of the Issaquah-Redmond Road, No. 1011; thence southeasterly along said centerline to the intersection of a line whose northerly projection bears N20 16'11"E from a point which lies on the southwesterly margin of the railroad right of way arc a distance of 344 feet when measured along said right of way arc from the intersection of said right of way margin and the west line of Government Lot 2; thence S20 16'11"W to the easterly shoreline of Lake Sammamish; thence southeasterly along said shoreline to the west line of Section 16 of said township and range; thence continuing southeasterly along said shoreline to the south line of the north 450 feet of Government Lot 2 in said Section 16; thence easterly along the south line of the north 450 feet of Government Lot 2 to the

centerline of the Issaquah-Redmond Road, No. 1011; thence northwesterly along said centerline to the south line of Government Lot 1 of said Section 16; thence easterly along said south line to the southeast corner of said Government Lot 1; thence northerly along the east line of said Government Lot 1 and the east line of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter to the northeast corner of said subdivision; thence westerly along the north line of said subdivision to the southeast corner of Section 8 of said township and range; thence northerly along the east line of said Section 8 to the north line of the south half of the southeast quarter of said Section 8; thence westerly along said north line to the westerly line of 212th Way S.E.; thence southerly along said west line to a point 100 feet south of the north line of the south half of said southeast quarter; thence west along said line to a point 300 feet west of the east line of said Section 8; thence northerly along a line parallel to and 300 feet westerly of the east line of said Section 8 to a point 600 feet south of of the north line of said Section 8; thence westerly along a line parallel to and 600 feet south of the north line of said Section 8 to the east line of the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of said Section 8; thence southerly along said east line of the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter to a point 198 feet north of the south line of the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of said Section 8; thence westerly along a line parallel to and 198 feet north of said south line to a point 300 feet east of the north-south centerline of said Section 8; thence southerly along a line parallel to and 300 feet east of said north-south centerline to the south line of the northeast quarter of said Section 8; thence westerly along said south line to the northwest corner of the southeast quarter of said Section 8 and the true point of beginning.
