ORDINANCE NO. 4400

AN ORDINANCE relating to establishment of

236th Ave. S.E. & 234th Ave. S.E.
(SE. 24th Street Northerly 2832.42 Ft.)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The Director of the Department of Public Works and Transportation has made an examination of 236th Ave. S.E. & 234th Ave. S.E. along the course and description set forth below and has made a favorable report upon the same, as required by R.C.W. 36.81.050.

SECTION 2: Said road shall be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at a point on the centerline of S.E. 24th Street at the intersection of 236th Avenue S.E., said point being S 88° 10' 56" E a distance of 30.00 feet from the south 1/4 corner of Sec. 3, Twp. 24 N., R. 6 E., W.M.; THENCE in a northerly direction a distance of 2832.42 feet to a terminus on the east-west center section line of said Sec. 3, said terminus being N 88° 09' 13" W a distance of 574.15 feet from the center of said Sec. 3.

2832.42 feet = 0.536 mile

SECTION 3: King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway, along the course and description set forth, is a public necessity.
