ORDINANCE NO. 4402

AN ORDINANCE relating to establishment of

S.W. 150th Street
(6th Ave. SW to 2nd Ave. SW)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The Director of the Department of Public Works and Transportation has made an examination of S.W. 150th Street along the course and description set forth below and has made a favorable report upon the same, as required by R.C.W. 36.81.050.

SECTION 2: Said road shall be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of existing S.W. 150th Street and the centerline of 6th Avenue S.W. in the NE 1/4 of Sec. 19, Twp. 23 N., Range 4 E., W.M., THENCE, running S 89° 37' 48" E a distance of 1317.60 feet to a terminus at the centerline of 2nd Avenue S.W.

1317.60 feet = 0.25 mile

SECTION 3: King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway, along the course and description set forth, is a public necessity.
