

ORDINANCE NO. 4408

AN ORDINANCE approving the Water Comprehensive Plan FOR Water District 90.

PREAMBLE:

On January 17, 1978, Water District 90 passed Resolution No. 334 adopting the District's Comprehensive Water Plan.

On February 21, 1978, Water District 90 filed a Declaration of Non-Significance for the proposed plan.

The Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed plan as required by KCC 13.23 and on March 29, 1979 recommended its conditional approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Comprehensive Water Plan of Water District 90 as adopted by district Resolution No. 334 (attached) is hereby approved; provided that improvements to the district's system involving pumping, source, storage or transmission mains shall be limited to those necessary to serve existing or permitted uses until the adoption of the Newcastle Communities Plan. Existing or permitted uses shall not be construed to mean subdivisions, short subdivisions or planned unit developments which have not received preliminary approval as of the effective date of this ordinance.
