

ORDINANCE NO. 4409

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as P-257 to Cascade Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as P-257 to Cascade Sewer District was filed with the County Council effective March 10, 1978.

2. Cascade Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 797, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Cascade Sewer District filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated February 16, 1978, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 10th day of April, 1978, and on the 30th day of July, 1979, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Cascade Sewer District of the area known as P-257 and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as P-257 to be annexed is described as follows:

1 The Plat of Meridian Estates No. 2 as recorded in
2 Volume 35, of Plats, page 45, records of King County,
Washington;

3 AND

4 The Plat of Chardot Manor as recorded in Volume 94 of
5 Plats, page 11, records of King County, Washington;

6 AND

7 The West half of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest
8 quarter of Section 35, Township 22 North, Range 5 East,
W.M.;

9 AND

10 That portion of the East half of the Southwest quarter
11 of the Northwest quarter of Section 35, Township 22
North, Range 5 East, W.M. lying Easterly of and
adjacent to said Plat of Chardot Manor;

12 EXCEPT the South half of Tax Lot 9.
