

ORDINANCE NO. 4410

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as P-261 to Cascade Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as P-261 to Cascade Sewer District was filed with the County Council effective May 23, 1978.

2. Cascade Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 806, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Cascade Sewer District filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated March 16, 1978, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 19th day of June, 1978, and on the 30th day of July, 1979, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Cascade Sewer District of the area known as P-261 and described in Section 2 herein is approved.
