

ORDINANCE NO. 0004447

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Flatum to King County Water District No. 82.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Flatum to King County Water District No. 82 was filed with the County Council effective July 24, 1979.

2. King County Water District No. 82 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution A-389, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 82 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated July 5, 1979, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 20th day of August, 1979, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 82 of the area known as Flatum and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Flatum to be annexed is described as follows:

1 Beginning at the point of intersection of the north
 2 line of Section 32, Township 25 North, Range 6 East,
 3 W.M., and the centerline of the Issaquah-Redmond Road
 4 situated in King County, Washington; thence southerly
 5 along said centerline to the westerly projection of a
 6 line 231 feet north of and parallel to the sough line
 7 of the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of
 8 said Section 32; thence easterly along said westerly
 9 projection and a line 231 feet north of and parallel to
 10 the south line of the northwest quarter of the
 11 northeast quarter of said Section 32, to the east line
 12 of the west half of the northeast quarter of said
 13 Section 32; thence northerly along the east line of the
 14 west half of the northeast quarter of said Section 32,
 15 to the north line of said Section 32; thence westerly
 16 along the north line of said Section 32, to the
 17 centerline of the Issaquah-Redmond Road and the point
 18 of beginning.
