

ORDINANCE NO. 0004448

AN ORDINANCE relating to the King County International Airport; establishing the maximum number of times which a plane may land during defined nighttime hours; and adding a new section to KCC 15.16.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is added to KCC 15.16 a new section to read as follows:

Nighttime Landings--Maximum Number. No aircraft may perform "touch and go landings" (i.e., an operation by an aircraft that lands and departs on a runway without stopping or exiting the runway) during a nighttime period. For purposes of this section, "nighttime period" shall mean a period commencing at ten P.M. and ending at seven A.M. the following day. In addition all nighttime flight activities shall be restricted to the west runway (31L - 13R). No nighttime flight operations shall take place on the east runway (31R - 13L).

Nothing in this section shall be deemed to prevent the Federal Aviation Administration Air Traffic Control Tower from utilizing any runway at any time to ensure the safe operation of aircraft.
