

ORDINANCE NO. 0004451

AN ORDINANCE relating to establishment of 244th Avenue NE (NE 170th Street [If Extended] to NE 200th Street) NE 200th Street (244th Avenue NE to 236th Avenue NE) and 236th Avenue NE (NE 200th Street to King -Snohomish County Line)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The Director of the Department of Public Works and Transportation has made an examination of 244th Avenue NE, NE 200th Street and 236th Avenue NE along the course and description set forth below and has made a favorable report upon the same, as required by R.C.W. 36.81.050.

SECTION 2: Said road shall be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at a point on the East line of Section 10, Township 26 North, Range 6 East, W.M., King County, Washington, said point being S 0°59'52" W 1,353.89 feet from the East 1/4 corner of said Section 10 and also known as Engineer's Station 3+02.88 as surveyed by King County Survey No. 10-26-6-4 on the centerline of 244th Avenue NE; thence N 0°59'52" E 1,353.89 feet; thence N 3°34'10" E 2,569.70 feet; thence N 3°14'38" E 2,662.25 feet; thence N 0°34'44" W 1,233.89 feet; thence N 88°53'28" W 2,623.10 feet; thence N 2°21'37" E 1,163.19 feet to a terminus at the North 1/4 corner of Section 3, Township 26 North, Range 6 East, W.M.

11,606.02 Feet = 2.198 Miles

SECTION 3: King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway, along the course and description set forth, is a public necessity.
