ORDINANCE NO. **0004492**

AN ORDINANCE granting interim approval to the Water District 82 Water Comprehensive Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On June 10, 1970, Water District 82 passed Resolution No. A160 adopting a Comprehensive Plan for the district.

The area which Water District 82 serves (East Sammamish Plateau) is presently the subject of a Community Planning Process.

Prior to the adoption of the East Sammamish Communities Plan, it would be unreasonable to expect Water District 82 to prepare a new comprehensive plan.

As required by KCC 13.24, the Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the comprehensive plan and on August 22, 1979 recommended its interim approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Water District 82 Water Comprehensive Plan as adopted by district Resolution No. A160 (attached) is hereby granted interim approval only to the extent that the facilities provided for by the comprehensive plan have been constructed or installed. This approval shall be valid for a period not to exceed twelve months after the adoption of the East Sammamish Communities Plan by the King County Council.

SECTION 2. The Utilities Technical Review Committee is hereby authorized to review and approve, on a case by case basis, facilities which are shown or provided for in the Water District 82 Water Comprehensive Plan described in Section 1 of this Ordinance, but which are not approved by Section 1 of this Ordinance. Any such approvals shall be limited to:

a. New significant general purpose facilities consistent with the provisions of KCC 13.24.050; and

b. Other facilities which are necessary to serve:

(1) existing or permitted uses, or

(2) plats, short plats or planned unit developments which

1 have received preliminary approval consistent with the criteria
2 of Ordinance No. 4308, Section 3.

3 SECTION 3. Any subsequent amendments to the Water District
4 82 Comprehensive Plan, prior to the adoption of the East
5 Sammamish Communities Plan will be considered by King County
6 pursuant to the provisions of KCC 13.24.
