ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Inabnit to Lakehaven Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Inabnit to Lakehaven Sewer District was filed with the County Council effective September 6, 1979.

2. Lakehaven Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 79-693, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Lakehaven Sewer District filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated August 14, 1979, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 1st day of October, 1979, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Lakehaven Sewer District of the area known as Inabnit and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Inabnit to be annexed is described as follows:

1 That portion of the Northeast quarter of Section 2,
2 Township 21 North, Range 4 East, W.M. in King County,
Washington, described as follows:

3 Beginning at a point on the East line of said Northeast
4 quarter and 1236 feet North of the Southeast corner
thereof;

5 Thence Southerly along said East line 199.80 feet;

6 Thence Westerly parallel to the South line of said
Northeast quarter 1141.80 feet;

7 Thence Northerly parallel to the East line of said
8 Northeast quarter 199.80 feet;

9 Thence Easterly parallel to the South line of said
10 Northeast quarter 363.80 feet;

11 Thence South to the intersection with the North margin
of Meredith Road (65th Avenue South);

12 Thence Easterly along the North margin of Meredith Road
13 (65th Avenue South) to the intersection with the East
line of said Northeast quarter;

14 Thence Southerly to the Point of Beginning.
