ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to traffic control, establishing a passenger curb loading zone on the north side of Southwest 149th Street in the vicinity of 6th Avenue Southwest and amending King County Ordinance 1100, Schedule 19.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to traffic engineering studies, and as authorized by KCC 46.61.575-4 adopting RCW 46.61.575, Schedule 19 of the King County Traffic Code which establishes passenger curb loading zones along county roads is amended to add the following location:

SOUTHWEST 149TH STREET, on the north side beginning at a point 65 feet west of 6th Avenue Southwest, thence westerly for a distance of 60 feet.

SECTION 2. Signs posted to evidence the above described restriction shall be installed by the proper authority.
