2 AN ORDINANCE relating to the Department of  
3 Public Works and Transportation; establishing  
4 a Division of Administrative Services;  
5 amending Ordinance No. 1438, Section 3(a),  
6 and KCC 2.16.040.

7 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

8 SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 1438, Section 3(a), and KCC  
9 2.16.040 are hereby amended to read as follows:

10 Department of Public Works and Transportation - Duties -  
11 Divisions. (a) The Department of Public Works and Transportation  
12 shall be responsible for the administration of the Divisions of  
13 Engineering, Solid Waste, Airport, Hydraulics, other related  
14 utility, public works and transportation functions. The  
15 Department shall be composed of the following divisions:

16 (1) ENGINEERING DIVISION. The Engineering Division  
17 shall be responsible for the administration of the county roads  
18 and streets system, including road/street design, construction,  
19 maintenance programs, and the administration and operation of  
20 engineering and central automotive functions.

21 (2) AIRPORT DIVISION. The Airport Division shall be  
22 responsible for the administration of King County Airport(s),  
23 including the implementation of county policy regarding airport  
24 development, the enforcement of King County Code rules and  
25 regulations regarding airport operations, and the administration  
26 of the fiscal and operating activities of county airport(s).

27 (3) SOLID WASTE DIVISION. The Solid Waste Division  
28 shall be responsible for the administration of the county solid  
29 waste program which provides for the disposal and recycling of  
30 solid waste of King County households and industries.

31 (4) HYDRAULICS DIVISION. The Hydraulics Division  
32 shall be responsible for the administration of county surface  
33 water management programs, including construction and maintenance  
programs which implement county policy as it relates to the  
regulation of drainage and the prevention of floods.

1 (b) A water and sewer utility section is established  
 2 within the King County Department of Public Works and  
 3 Transportation in accordance with RCW 36.94.120, the County Area  
 4 Services Act. Personnel of the water and sewer utility section  
 5 shall be employed in accordance with provisions of a personnel  
 6 merit system as established in Chapter 3.12.

7 (5) ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES DIVISION. The Administrative  
 8 Services Division shall be responsible for the administration of  
 9 intradepartmental services and the coordination of functions with  
 10 other appropriate agencies to include activities involving  
 11 financial investments and budget control, word processing and  
 12 records retention, claims investigation and complaint  
 13 resolution, policy development, preparation of administrative  
 14 rules as required by general law, and personnel services,  
 15 including the administration of approved collective bargaining  
 16 agreements.
