ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to Taxicabs; amending Ordinance 1120, Section 2 and K.C.C. 6.64.020.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1120, Section 2 and K.C.C. 6.64.020 are hereby amended as follows:

License - Applications. It is unlawful to own, operate, or engage in the business of operating a taxicab or for-hire car in the unincorporated areas of King County without first having obtained, for each and every vehicle so used, a license from the director, to be known as a for-hire or taxicab license. Licenses shall be obtained in the following manner and under the following conditions:

(a) The applicant for such license, in a manner approved by the director shall show in his application: the true name and address of the applicant, and if a corporation, the names and addresses of the principal officers and shareholders thereof, the classification under which the vehicle will be operated, whether as taxicab or other vehicle for hire; the year for which the license is sought; and shall furnish full, true and accurate information concerning the ownership, identification, company vehicle number, the name of the business, fictitious or otherwise under which the vehicle is to be operated, the distinguishing color scheme, design or dress, including any monogram or insignia to be used on such vehicle or vehicles, whether he has been convicted of any violation within ten years preceding the date of application related to the sale or possession of intoxicating liquor, gambling or any law or ordinance involving an intent to defraud, or whether the applicant has ever been convicted of any law or ordinance relating to the use sale or possession of narcotic drugs or barbiturates, or any such other information the director may require, which he deems reasonably necessary to aid in the enforcement of this chapter.

(b) The director shall inquire into the correctness of the information furnished, and if so satisfied, after due investigation, that the applicant is the reliable and bona fide owner of the motor vehicle, has met the various requirements of this chapter, that the name under which the applicant is to operate and the color scheme used upon the motor vehicle does not conflict with others so used, or tend to deceive the public, that the motor vehicle is equipped with proper state license and city of Seattle license, if applicable, and is properly insured for the protection of the public as required by law, a license may thereupon be issued in accordance with the provisions of this chapter, authorizing the operation of the motor vehicle under the classification applied for.

(c) A license may be denied to any person if the director, after due investigation, has reason to believe that the applicant is dishonest or immoral, or desires such license to enable him to engage in a dishonest, unlawful, or immoral act, practice or enterprise. Wilful falisification or omission of any information required in the application shall constitute grounds for denial of the license.
