

ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE relating to the withdrawal of an area known as Resolution 79-9-19F from King County Water District No. 75.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the withdrawal of an area known as Resolution 79-9-19F from King County Water District No. 75 was filed with the County Council effective November 5, 1979.

2. King County District No. 75 has found the petition for withdrawal to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 79-9-19F, concurred with the proposed withdrawal.

3. King County Water District No. 75 filed a Declaration of Nonsignificant Impact dated July 19, 1979, on the proposed withdrawal.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 3rd day of December, 1979, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The withdrawal from King County Water District No 75 of the area known as Resolution 79-9-19F, and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Resolution 79-9-19F, to be withdrawn, is described as follows:

1 That portion of the north 1/2 of the northeast 1/2 of the  
2 southwest 1/4 of Section 33, Township 22 North, Range 4  
3 East, W.M., lying westerly of the westerly margin of  
primary State Highway No. 1.
